Grants for children and young people with SEND

<u>Cash for Kids</u> – Grants for children who are affected by poverty, illness, neglect, or disability for a wide range of items including household items, therapies, leisure activities, and specialist equipment.

<u>Caudwell Children</u> – Provide specialist mobility and sensory equipment for disabled and neurodivergent children and young people.

<u>Cheyn Charity</u> – Grants for children with Cerebral Palsy for specialist equipment, wheelchairs, therapies and electronic aids.

<u>Boparian Trust</u> – Grants for children with disabilities, life limiting conditions or living in extreme poverty for specialist equipment, therapies and household appliances

<u>Family Fund</u> – Grants for families who have a disabled child for items which will help support their additional needs and make your family life easier. This includes white goods, technology, and or a family break.

<u>Children Today</u> – Grants for children and young adults up to the age of 25 years with disabilities for specialist equipment

<u>CHIPS Charity</u> – Provides wheelchairs for children which the NHS is unable to provide or parent/carers are unable to afford

<u>Crackerjacks Children's Trust</u> – Grants for children with disabilities up to the age of 16 years for specialist equipment or sensory toys. Applications also accepted for a stay at their holiday home.

<u>Elifar Foundation</u> – Grants for children and young adults up to the age of 28 years with a severe learning disability and associated physical disability, for specialist equipment

<u>Florence Nightingale Aid in Sickness Trust</u> – Grants for children and adults who are ill or disabled for specialist equipment, and white goods

<u>Lifeline 4 Kids</u> – Grants for children with disabilities for specialist equipment

<u>Newlife Charity</u> – Grants for children with disabilities or who are terminally ill for specialist equipment.

<u>React</u> – Rapid assistance for children with a life limiting or potentially terminal condition living in financially disadvantaged households for specialist medical, sensory or mobility equipment.

<u>Variety</u> – Grants for children with disabilities or who are disadvantaged for specialist equipment and outdoor play equipment.

<u>Whizz Kidz</u> – Provides wheelchairs for children which the NHS is unable to provide or parent/carers are unable to afford
